

## **REENROLL FOR THE 2024–2025 SCHOOL YEAR**

Reenroll your student for the coming year! Completing reenrollment secures your student's place in class and also helps us plan for the next school year. To get started, log into your FACTS Family Portal, select "Apply/Enroll" from the left side, then select "Enrollment/Reenrollment" for current students. If you are adding a new student, click "Application." For your new student, be sure to select "2024-2025 Current Family Application."

Families who know they are transferring their students to another school are also able to let us know by logging into the Family Portal following the instructions above. Once you are in the area that lists the enrollment packets, click the link to the right marked "Will Not Enroll."


