

Cookie Dough is sold in 1 oz. pre-portion cookie packages. (40 cookies). All you have to do is just break and bake! The dough is delivered frozen - made to order – no scooping and no mess! What a great way for families, children, seniors, and singles to have delicious homemade cookies!

Additionally, we are offering **Rite Bite's Butter Braids**. These are hand-braided pastries that bake into a delicious breakfast or dessert entrees. They are 22 oz. in size and come in in **SIX different** flavors:

- Apple, Cinnamon, Cream Cheese, Raspberry, Strawberry & Cream Cheese, and Cinnamon Rolls

Parents will need to pick up their orders in the MPR between 2:30pm-3pm or 3:30pm-4:30pm that day. (There will be no pickup from 3-3:30 due to TCS dismissal.) This will be a CURBSIDE pickup. Please CLEARLY display your name as you pull up and our Student Council and staff will deliver your order directly to your vehicle.
