All students experiencing diarrhea, fever, or vomiting must be symptom-free, without the help of medication, for 24 hours before returning to school. All students sent home with any of these symptoms will be excluded from class until they have been symptom-free for 24 hours. For example, a child who throws up at 11 a.m. must stay home until at least 11 a.m. the following day.
