8th Grade Retreat

A highlight of eighth grade year at TCS is the kick-off retreat to Cup of Cold Water. The main goals for this retreat are for the students to grow in their relationship with Christ, create a stronger bond as a class, and reflect on how to leave a legacy at Trinity Christian School.

In order to accomplish those goals, the students engage in a variety of activities, including quiet time, praise and worship, and time in small groups; hearing messages provided throughout the retreat by Mr. V, challenging them to be leaders and leave a legacy at TCS; participating in games and activities that create fun memories and build trust in each other; and fun activities like late night dance parties, s'mores around a campfire, and their favorite: capture the flag at night!

"One thing that impacted me was the main message of leaving a legacy. Mr. V said that a legacy is something handed down by someone that is impactful, and I wish I can be that for someone else! I am grateful for how the retreat set up my final year at Trinity." - Genevieve C.

To close out the retreat, the students write a goal letter to themselves focused on specific goals they have for the year. Students may focus their goal letters on academics, athletics, their faith journey, personal lives, and more. Students talk about what makes a good goal, how to have accountability, focused disciplines, positivity and drive.

The students love this retreat and we love how it sets them up for a successful and impactful year!








ALUMNI SPOTLIGHT
